T1-1 Keeping Journal with Renee Plains

Renee will be showing how to make a small fabric covered journal (6" x 9") to keep your notes, quilt ideas and lists with you. The appliqué cover design includes an alphabet, a pot of flowers and a bird. You will easily be able to use the journal cover again by making new signatures from letter size paper.

T1-2 Sewing Machine Guard Doll with Lynda Hall

Join Linda and make this funky doll to sit by your machine and keep those evil scissor hiding, thread knotting gremlins away. She (the doll, not Lynda) has a spool necklace, rusty pins for her hair, a place to keep scissors and of course, she's the pin cushion. She's got a flap on her backside to keep needles (yes, the doll, not Lynda)...a regular little helper for sure!

T2-1 Small Sewing Basket with Barb Reininger

This small (5" x 8") sewing basket has a special dowel rod through the handle to hold your spools of thread. A great little basket to take to your guild or sewing bee. All supplies included as well as tools needed. You will complete the basket in class and stain if desired.

T2-2 My Old Neighbor with Renee Plains

This wall quilt with appliquéd house blocks uses Rita's great invisible machine appliqué technique. This quick appliqué technique will help you to complete appliqué projects in record time!

T2-3 Strawberry Queen Pincushion with Stacy Nash

Have you been admiring lovely pieces like Stacy's but aren't sure about your stitching skills? This sweet little Pincushion measures 7" wide by 5" high and is stitched on 28-count Wichelt Raw Linen with 2 strands of DMC floss over 2 strands of linen. It's a great project for beginners.

T3-1 Pomegranate Table Rug with Sue Spargo

Adorn your festive table with a 42" x 12" pomegranate table rug made from a combination of driftwood dyed wools for the background and a fun wool, cotton and silk velvet appliqué. We will then embellish it with beads, ribbons, hand dyed rick-racks and yarns. These will add texture and interest to your project giving each one an individual style. We will learn many different stitches using hand dyed fibers.

T3-2 Quilt with Cherie Ralston

Create a great appliqué quilt using Cherie's technique.

F1-1 Patriotic Purse with Barb Reininger

This is the purse that my assistant (mom) carried last year. It is a patriotic basket with a wood base and a leather strap. It is a beauty that really shows your patriotism. All supplies included as well as tools needed. You will complete the basket in class and stain if desired.

F1-2 Angel Wall Hanging with Lynda Hall

Spend the morning with Lynda and make a great angel wall hanging using fabric and wool appliqué. Four funky angels are separated by flying geese sashing. Primitive and whimsical...what more could you want?

F1-3 Bird & Berries Pinkeep Drum w/Strawberry Emery with Stacy Nash

The kit for this project will be sent out the end of June so some stitching can be done at home. The Drum and the Velvet Berry can then be finished in class. This sweet little Drum is stitched on 32-count Wichelt Raw Linen with 1 strand of DMC floss over 2 strands of linen. It's stuffed with sawdust and it measures 5" high by 3 1/4" in diameter. The Strawberry Emery is filled with a nice heavyweight emery and the top is a nice silk matka.

F2-1 Showcase Tote with Barb Reininger

This large wood-bottom tote will measure about 14" h x 12" l x 6" wide. The handle will go long ways so you could "showcase" a needlework design on the front...punch needle, wool work, even a small quilt. All supplies are included as well as tools needed. You supply the "showcase" piece later! You will complete the basket in class as well as stain if desired.

F2-2 May Baskets - Wool Appliqué Table Runner with Lynda Hall

Make this delightful table runner with Lynda. Her sample is approximately 66" x 20". This design has wool appliqué baskets of flowers on each end. It's designed so the center is plain – perfect placement for a bowl or basket. You'll want to measure your own table so your completed runner will fit your table perfectly!

F2-3 Schoolgirl Sewing Roll with Stacy Nash

This sweet little Sewing Roll sampler is stitched on 32-count Wichelt Raw Linen using 1 strand of DMC floss over 2 strands of linen. At the top of the sampler is a little piece of tan homespun with a straight stitched primitive heart. The outside of the Roll is a piece of pre-washed olive green silk matka and it ties closed with brown silk ribbon. The Sewing Roll measures 5" wide by 14" long

F3-1 A Summer in my Garden Wool Runner with Maggie Bonanomi

Join Maggie and make this 11 ½" x 33" wool runner. The background is pieced together. This piece is a "sampler" of sorts with lambs tongues, flowers, a goofy bird and pennies. Colors are "browny" black, greens, "bluey" greens and rust.

Fee: \$125 includes kit

F3-2 Hollyhock Pin Keeper & Needle Keeper with Sue Spargo

Create these two colorful keepers to safely and beautifully store your pins and needles.

F3-3 I'll Be Home for Christmas Quilt with Lisa Bongean

Get ready for the Christmas season with this great quilt designed by Lisa. The blocks finish at 4 ½" – that means those half-square triangles finish at ¾". Learn how to make these little guys with Lisa!

S1-1 Halloween Quilt with Barb Adams and Alma Allen

Spend the morning with Barb and Alma and make a small 'boo'tiful quilt that's perfect for Halloween. This same class is offered Saturday afternoon

S1-2 "Radish" Veggie Pin with Maggie Bonanomi

Maggie's unique radish pin is approximately 5" long. It will look great pinned on a shirt or jacket. It's so cute you'll want to display it – maybe in a wooden bowl – when it's not being worn.

S1-3 Pinkeep Sewing Box with Renee Plains

A fabric covered sewing box to hold a small project along with thread, needles, scissors and pins. This vintage looking sewing box makes a nice sewing room accessory.

Fee: \$55 plus kit and supplies

S1-4 Liberty Hill Pocket Roll with Stacy Nash

This kit will be sent out the end of June so some of the stitching can be completed at home. Class will be more on the finishing of the project. This is a brand new design. I've stitched on 32-count Wichelt Dirty Linen with 1 strand of DMC floss over 2 strands of linen. Inside the pocket is lined with red and tan plaid homespun and the outside of the Pocket Roll is a wonderful silk matka. It rolls up and ties with silk ribbon. The Pocket Roll measures 8" wide by 15" long.

S1-5 Christmas Journal Cover with Lisa Bongean

S2-1 Wearable Wool Pocket Purse with Maggie Bonanomi

Maggie will be teaching another one of her unique wool projects. This time it's a wool appliquéd 5" x 7 ½" pocket purse with a leather strap, buttoned closure and small buttoned pocket on the back. Kit includes 2 old buttons. (Project photo available)

Spend the afternoon with Barb and Alma and make a small 'boo'tiful quilt that's perfect for Halloween. This same class is offered Saturday morning.

S3-1 Stitch Journal – Wool Embellishment with Sue Spargo

This will be a hands-on creative embellishment class. You will receive a small hand dyed wool kit with a bird design which you will appliqué before you come to class. We will then spend the day exploring various techniques using taffeta silk, ultra suede and hand dyed silk velvet. We will be finishing using an array of embroidery stitches using wonderful fibers which will make your bird, branch, flower, berry and leaf design come to life.

Fee: \$115 includes kit

Class Policies
