Town Square . A Study in Precision Piecing from the Beginning

Join Harriet for two days and upgrade your precision piecing skills. This class will go into many subjects that are left out of project classes. A few of the topics covered by hands on experience when piecing the quilt top will be: straightening the grain of your fabrics, finding your "true" accurate seam allowance on your sewing machine, learning to press accurately and with a purpose, planning a pressing system and above all extreme accuracy. Your quilt tops' back will look as good as the front. Some piecing experience is helpful, but whether you are a beginner or advanced beginner, if your 12" blocks are not perfectly 12" finished, you can really get a lot out of this workshop.

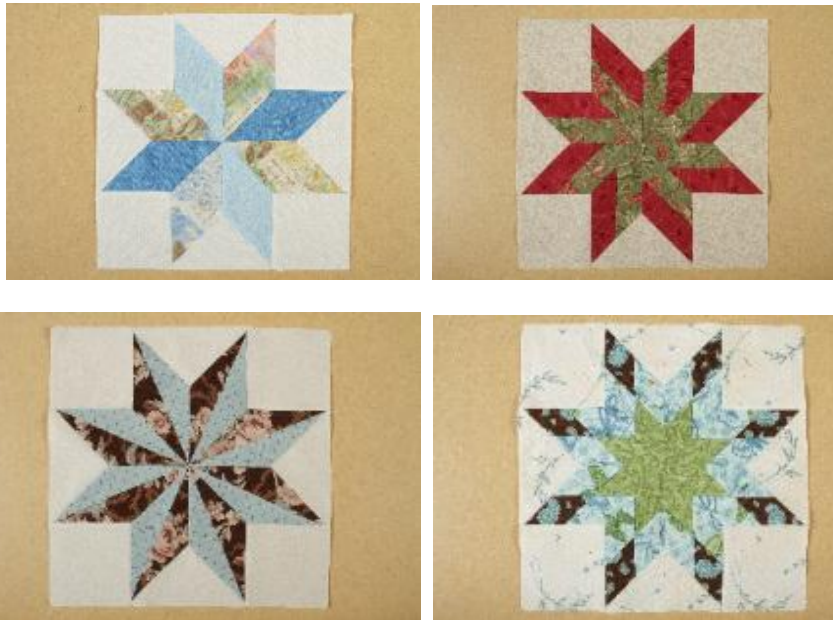

LeMoyne Stars Basic 45 stars

These 45 stars are the foundation of so many wonderful block designs. Once you understand how they go together and work through the techniques to making them flat, square and accurate, you will find they become one of your favorite blocks! You start the class learning how to draft the block, after which you will be making a 12 and a couple of 6 blocks using both templates and rotary cutting methods.

60 DIAMOND

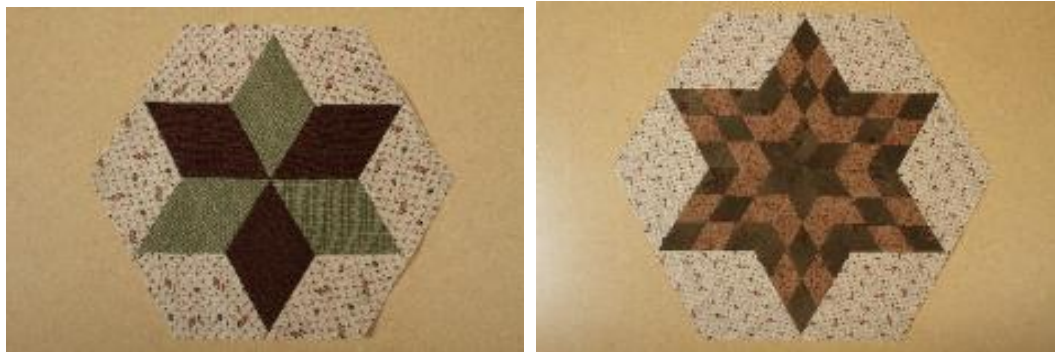

60 diamonds have endless uses, and the stars made with them are amazingly easy once you know the tricks of getting perfect points. Whether you do a simple one piece diamond star, a 9-patch diamond star, or even a star using up to 18 fabrics, they are different and stunning. We will discuss the basics of drafting these stars, make a simple star and move onto a 9-patch star. You'll have fun discovering how easy they can be, as well as mastering set in corners.
